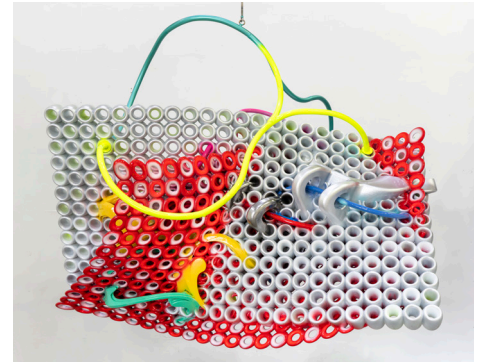
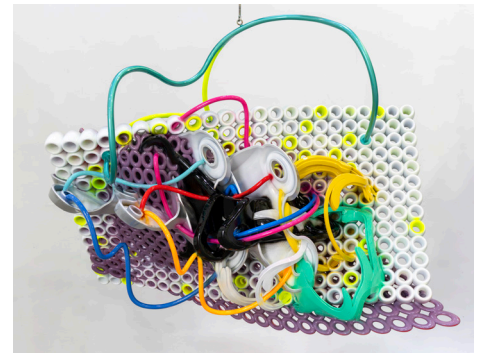

Directly from his studio, a large selection of works spanning three decades of Frank Stella's prolific career will be on view. The exhibition features numerous wall and table pieces including *Bali*, *Scarlati Kirkpatrick*, *Stars*, *Atlantic Salmon Rivers*, and *Marshmallows*, which are representative of several of the artist's iconic series. In addition, *Beyond the Reef* from 2023, a large-scale, painted work will be suspended from a steel armature in a dedicated gallery space.

In 2021, Yares Art presented, *As it Was, As it Is*, a two-person exhibition featuring the early and late paintings as well as sculptures by Stella in tandem with a selection of works by Larry Poons spanning the years 1960–2020. Highlighted in the exhibition catalogue, Stella's *Jasper's Split Star*—a monumental work from 2017—was permanently installed in Survivor's Park in front of World Trade Center Tower Seven, shortly after the 20th commemorative anniversary of 9/11.
